

Gilbert/Liberty Arts Academy's 6th Grade Camp

Our 6th grade students will be attending "Camp Sky-Y" in Prescott, AZ from May 1st– May 3rd. We will be going as a combined group.

The camp is for 3 days and 2 nights and costs \$175. The fee includes:

- Food and enclosed cabin lodging for two (2) nights
- Exclusive charter bus to and from camp in Prescott, AZ
- Exclusive 2019 camp t-shirt
- Exciting group and individual activities, including high ropes, archery and a campfire

Payment options

ECA method - Full Payment: \$175 by Dec 31, 2018.

Must fill out ECA donation paperwork and receive a \$ for \$ credit on your 2018 Arizona state taxes, or

ECA method – Installments:

\$60 by Dec 31, 2018 &

\$60 by Feb 8, 2019 &

\$55 by Mar 5, 2019

Must fill out ECA donation paperwork each payment and receive \$ for \$ credit on taxes for 2018, or

Cash, check or money orders paid to the office. Full payment by Dec 31, 2018 or installments on the dates detailed above.

YMCA Camp Sky-Y and Chauncey Ranch Packing List for a 2 night trip.

NOTE: Participants should be limited to ONE small suitcase or small duffle bag (they can carry), and 1 large garbage bag for your sleeping bag/pillow. All items should be marked with your name.

NECESSARY

- 2 pairs of shoes appropriate for walking/hiking around camp.
- 1 poncho or raincoat
- 1 or 2 pairs of long pants or jeans
- 1 or 2 pairs of shorts.
- 1 heavy fleece or sweatshirt (it gets cool at night)
- 1 warm shirt
- 2 T-shirts
- Laundry bag or pillow case for dirty laundry
- Bath towel
- Soap and other toiletries.
- Comb or brush
- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Sleeping bag or sheet/blanket set
- Pillow
- Water bottle** (Very important!!)
- Day pack or small back pack
- Flashlight and extra batteries

WINTER ADDITIONS (Nov-March)

- Heavy coat or jacket
- Warm hat
- Scarf
- Mittens or warm gloves
- Extra pair of shoes
- Warm socks (wool or synthetic)
- Extra clothing to wear as layers (all classes are outside)

Because of elevation, expect the temperature at Sky-Y & Chauncey Ranch to be about 10-20 degrees colder during the day than it would be in the Phoenix area during the same season. At night temperatures can be 15-25 degrees cooler.

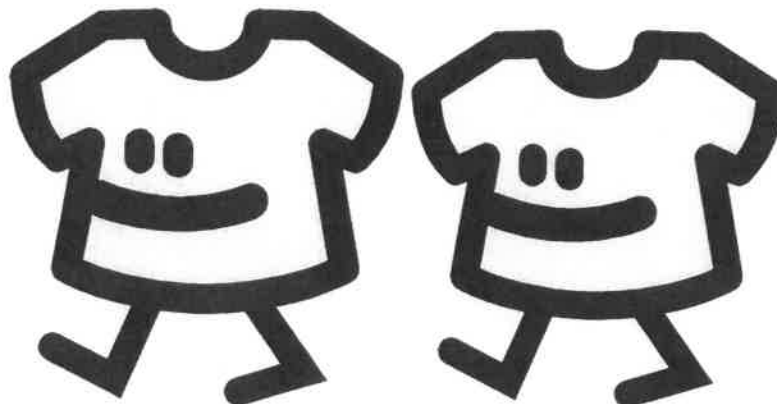
6th Grade Camp 2019

10. Quiet hours are from 10:00pm to 7:00am. I agree to respect others by keeping the lights off and my voice quiet during these hours, and to remain in my cabin during these hours (except to use the restroom)
11. No students are permitted in the cabins or anywhere at camp alone; you must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
